Denny Goodrich reviewed the history of the Norton Rail Trail project. Representatives from BETA explained the MassDOT process 1. First step. 25% design (preliminary design). It involves data collection, submission of the design and DOT review. In response to a question the BETA representatives said that SRPPD deals mostly with funding, and are kept up to date on the project.
 Design public hearing by MassDOT Mass DOT will want to hear general support for the project from the public. Town officers, the committee and the general public should be encouraged to attend the meeting.
