Call to Order

Vice-Chairman Medeiros made the motion to go to new business to accommodate the last minute appeal from 53 Bay Road. Chairman Corr seconded this motion. This motion passed 2-0 M. S. D. V.

Old Business

• 417 Old Colony Road

Health Agent Dumont stated that Mary Giorgio, Esq. the Town of Norton's Attorney has not heard from Henry Lane regarding the construction permit conditions the Board voted on at its April 11th Board of Health meeting.

• 246 East Main Street

Health Agent Dumont stated he received the laboratory testing results for the FAST system at 246 East Main Street. The Board reviewed this data, which indicated that the system is not functioning properly. The BOD and the suspended solids have increased beyond the limits for General Use system. After a brief discussion the following motion was made.

Vice-Chairman Medeiros made the motion based upon the latest testing data for the FAST system located at 246 East Main Street; they will be required to resume quarterly testing until the system meets the Department of Environmental Protections requirements. Chairman Corr seconded this motion. This motion passed 2-0 M. S. D. V.

Arrowhead

Health Agent Dumont stated that the Board of Health received the latest inspection and monitoring report for Arrowhead Village treatment plant located on Arrowhead Drive on March 31, 2011. Based upon this report the system is functioning fine.

New Business

• 53 Bay Road – Natalie Manderville requesting an appeal to the order delivered by Health Agent Dumont on Friday, April 29, 2011.

Health Agent Dumont stated that a complaint on the office voicemail indicated that the trash receptacle from 53 Bay Road was left out all week. After investigating the complaint a registered letter was sent to the property owners of 53 Bay Road, informing them that the trash receptacle must be put out for collection no earlier than the day of collection as specified in 105 CMR 410.600 (A). Failure to comply with the order could result in a fine of \$50.00 per day or under MGL Chapter 111 Section 122 they could be fined up to \$1,000.00. Health Agent Dumont further explained that the registered letter was not delivered. Agent Dumont hand delivered the letter.

The homeowners were present.

Ms. Manderville explained that she stores the trash in a receptacle outside the fence on her property put moves the receptacle to the end of her driveway for collection day.

Health Agent Dumont stated that according to the Highway Superintendent the street layout is 30 feet wide and extends to at least her fence line. Therefore, the trash receptacle is being stored on Town owned property.

Ms, Manderville asked if she could cut a hole in her fence and store the trash receptacle on her property.

Vice-Chairman Medeiros stated as long as the trash receptacle was sealed and not located on Town property the Board could not object. He also indicated the trash could only be move out to the street on the day of collection.

Vice-Chairman Medeiros made the motion to wait on fines allowing time for 53 Bay Road to comply with the order. Chairman Corr seconded this motion. This motion passed 2-0 M. S. D. V.
