Mr. Medeiros requested more research on the number of grease traps in the town and the Board will discuss a possible regulation at the next month. 2. Re-inspection fees for contractors and probation periods for new installers. Chairman Corr indicated a preference for charging at least \$50 per re-inspection. The Board will discuss these issues in more detail at the next meeting. Ms. Battistello asked about the Attleboro landfill closure plan. Mr. Corr deferred citing it as a DEP issue.
