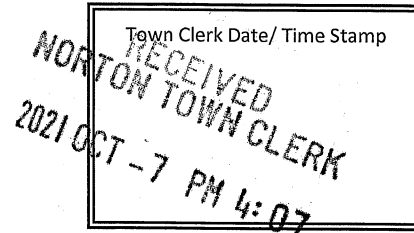

Call to order: Mr. Medeiros, Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:05 PM.

Acceptance of Minutes: Mr. Hebard made a motion to approve minutes from July 12, 2021 as written, Mr. Medeiros 2nd Vote 2-0 Approved

Consent Agenda: Approved

Old Business: Mr. Sullivan of Norton Mobile Estates, gave update on why he has not had a permit or sent in the approved rules & regulations for his mobile home park. He said that the rules and regulations have been submitted to the state as of 8/2/21 by email and certified mail. He brought in a hardcopy of the rules and regulations and a copy of the certified receipts. The State has 60 days to review without objection. Once Mr. Sullivan brings in proof of the state review, the permit application is signed off by all town departments and pay the last 5 years in license fees and late charges totaling \$625.00, we will then issue license to operate a Mobile Home Park.
