Members reviewed the draft Bills Payable Sheet. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Leo Yelle, to approve the payment of bills as submitted. Approved.

Members reviewed a proposal from P & A Construction for a single family house on Lot 100, Margaret Drive. Leo Yelle made a motion, seconded by Edd Breault, to issue a negative Determination of Applicability with the standard conditions plus the requirements that the applicant swale the area along the lot line of 100/101 so that surface runoff will not flow onto Lot 101 and that the lot line at 100/101 be staked prior to the start of work. Approved.

Members continued the review of proposed work on Lot 2, Dean Street (Hampshire Court). Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Edd Breault, to close the Public Hearing. Approved. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Edd Breault, to issue an Order of Conditions pending the submittal, by the applicant, of calculations regarding the proposed pipe size under the driveway crossing. Approved.

Members continued the review of proposed work on Lot 1, Dean Street (Hampshire Court). Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Dana Rappaneau, to close the Public Hearing. Approved. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Edd Breault, to issue an Order of Conditions pending the submittal, by the applicant, of calculations regarding the proposed pipe size under the driveway crossing. Approved.

Members reviewed a proposal by the Highway Department to redirect surface water flow on Oak Street to more adequately deal with stormwater runoff. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Leo Yelle, to continue the Public Hearing to Monday, October 25, 1993 at 8:15 p.m. due to the lack of a file number from DEP. Approved.

Members reviewed a proposal by Clarence Rich to cross an intermittent stream with a road to remove trees and conduct an agricultural project in an upland area. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Brian Langevin, to continue the Public Hearing to Monday, October 25, 1993 at 8:20 p.m. due to the lack of a file number from DEP. Approved.

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Members reviewed a request for an Extension Permit from Carol Lees, 1 Bay Road. Leo Yelle made a motion, seconded by Leonard Silvia, to issue a one-year Extension Permit. Approved.

Members reviewed a request for a change to the layout of the by-pass canal that is being excavated at the Fuller-Hammond cranberry bogs on Bay Road. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Leo Yelle, to approve said request. Approved.

Members reviewed the draft Order of Conditions for John Schneider for a proposed driveway crossing at Lot 1, John Scott Blvd. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Leo Yelle, to issue said document. Approved.

Members reviewed an as-built which had been submitted by Raymond Hebert, Jr. for the wetland replication area at 200 South Worcester Street. The area has been excavated and seeded. Leonard Silvia made a motion, seconded by Edd Breault, to issue a partial Certificate of Compliance pending the posting, by the applicant, of a \$500.00 bond to ensure final vegetative stabilization of the area (i.e. reseeded, if necessary). Approved.

The Conservation Director reported the details of a scheduled trash clean-up at Norton Reservoir, distributed an update of conditions at Misty Meadows and a list of members' telephone numbers, and advised the members of her need to take off at least a week of sick time on as yet unscheduled dates.
