Minutes

Members reviewed the Bills Payable Sheet. Patrick Corcoran made a motion, seconded by Ed Breault, to pay the bills. Approved.

Ed Breault, made a motion, seconded by Dana Rappaneau, to table review of the draft minutes of February 26, 1996 until the March 25th meeting. Approved.

Members reviewed a Request for a full Certificate of Compliance filed by James Elliott for lot 2, parcel 49 (assessors map 30) Maple St. (#250-341). Ed Breault made a motion, seconded by Dana Rappaneau, to hold off issuing the Certificate until the snow melts and the Director works out a few issues with the project.

Some discussion on house staking ensued but was tabled until the March 25th meeting.

Discussion on the Zoning By-Law Floodplain amendments ensued and it was decided that the Commission would review the proposal amendment and act on them at the next meeting.

Members reviewed a Request for a Determination of Applicability filed by J & R Enterprises, Inc. for lot 31, parcel 88 (assessors map 24) Pine Street for proposed construction of a single family house, driveway, retaining wall and utilities within the 100 ft. Buffer Zone of a pond and bordering vegetated wetlands (Det. #441). James Chabot represented himself as the applicant. Jeff Houde abstained from voting, and Julian Kadish was acting Chairman. Ed Breault made a motion, seconded by Dana Rappanea, to close the Public Meeting. Approved. Ed Breault made a motion, seconded by Patrick Corcoran, to issue a negative Determination of Applicability with conditions. Approved.
