Minutes

THERE WAS NO QUORUM FOR THIS MEETING

The members reviewed the Bills Payable Sheet (Misc.). Ron O'Reilly made a motion, seconded by Bob Medeiros, to pay the bill. Approved. One other member shall sign the Bills Payable Sheet and the signatures will be ratified at the next meeting.

The members reviewed the Bills Payable Sheet (Nextel). Bob Medeiros made a motion, seconded by Ron O'Reilly, to pay the bill. Approved. One other member shall sign the Bills Payable Sheet and the signatures will be ratified at the next meeting.

The members reviewed the Bills Payable Sheet (Pare Corporation/Norton Reservoir dam and Chartley Pond dam inspections). Bob Medeiros made a motion, seconded by Ron O'Reilly, to pay the bill. Approved. One other member shall sign the Bills Payable Sheet and the signatures will be ratified at the next meeting.

The members reviewed the Bills Payable Sheet (Pare Corporation/Norton Reservoir Repair Design). Ron O'Reilly made a motion, seconded by Bob Medeiros, to pay the bill. Approved. One other member shall sign the Bills Payable Sheet and the signatures will be ratified at the next meeting.

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Julian Kadish explained to the audience that there was no quorum this evening and all the projects would be continued until the next regular meeting of Monday, February 26, 2007 at the same time they were scheduled tonight.

The members reviewed a request for a duplicate Certificate of Compliance for File **#250-728**. Jennifer Carlino stated the owner lost the original Certificate. She stated three members could sign the duplicate Certificate of Compliance tonight and another member could sign the Certificate later and the signatures could be ratified at the next meeting. Bob Medeiros made a motion, seconded by Ron O'Reilly, to sign the duplicate Certificate of Compliance. Approved.

The members reviewed a modification to the Order of Conditions for File **#250-756 – David LeMieux/Sinclair Mfg. Co. – 12 South Worcester Street**. Jennifer Carlino stated the change would be that instead of spanning the bridge and hitting the bank with I beams, they would be able to go beyond and next to the bank to do their water testing. Jennifer Carlino stated that three members could vote to allow the modification and another member could ratify the vote at the next regular meeting of Monday, February 26, 2007. Bob Medeiros made a motion, seconded by Ron O'Reilly, to allow the modification as proposed. Approved.

Since there was no quorum, Jennifer Carlino stated three members could vote to accept and sign the following Order of Conditions and a fourth member could sign them later and the signatures could be ratified at the next regular meeting.

The members reviewed the Order of Conditions for Notice of Intent – **(#250-761) – Scott Goddard – Parcel 37-01 (assessors map 31) John Scott Boulevard** which was sent to the members with the agenda for review. Ron O'Reilly made a motion, seconded by Bob Medeiros, to accept the conditions as written and to sign the Order of Conditions. Approved.

The members reviewed the Order of Conditions for Notice of Intent – **(#250-760) – Fred Bottomley – Parcel 29 (assessors map 25) 21 Samoset Street** which was sent to the members with the agenda for review. Bob Medeiros made a motion, seconded by Ron O'Reilly, to accept the conditions as written and to sign the Order of Conditions. Approved.

The members reviewed the Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation – **(#250-759) – David Azanow/Bennett Mortgage & Investment Co., Inc. – Parcels 182, 185, 191 & 311 (assessors map 27) South Worcester Street** which was sent to the members with the agenda for review. Ron O'Reilly made a motion, seconded by Bob Medeiros, to accept the Order of Resource Area Delineation as written and to sign the Order. Approved.

The members reviewed the Order of Conditions for Notice of Intent – **(#250-763) – Robert Downey – Parcel 282 (assessors map 9) 154 Mansfield Avenue** which was sent to the members with the agenda for review. Bob Medeiros made a motion, seconded by Ron O'Reilly, to accept the conditions as written and to sign the Order of Conditions. Approved.

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Jennifer Carlino stated a decision has to be made on the Lake Winnecunnet project. She says that the recommendation that has been made is to use chemicals to treat the Lake to remove invasive plants. Bob Medeiros suggested to wait until the next meeting in order to have a full board to vote.


Jennifer Carlino stated a decision has to be made on the Norton Reservoir Dredging project. Discussion ensued on the method to be used. Bob Medeiros suggested to mine the Reservoir in sections and remove the material from the site immediately instead of dredging the Reservoir all at once. It was agreed to wait until the next meeting in order to have a full board to vote.

Jennifer Carlino stated that DEP accepted the appeal for File **DET. #893 – Lot 2-04, Parcel 63 (assessors map 6) Fairlee Lane.**

Jennifer Carlino stated she sent a letter to the Town Manager requesting to put an Article on the warrant for the next Town Meeting requesting to change the day on which Town Meetings would take place so they will not take place on the same day as Conservation Commission meetings.

Jennifer Carlino asked the Commission if they wanted to vote to accept the 1.1-acre parcel of land on Union Road proposed to be donated to the Commission by Norma Nelson. She stated a 21E test was performed and the site was deemed clean. The members were in favor of accepting the land but wanted to wait until the next regular meeting so the other members may have a chance to vote on this.
