Building Committee: Bob Briscoe not present, but Beth reported that the new building is really coming along. Target date for completion is end of May or June.

Director's Report: Beth reported that things at the Center are exceptionally busy with open enrollment and fuel assistance program. Open enrollment runs to December 15. Names of seniors and veterans are being taken for Thanksgiving meals in conjunction with St. Vincent D Paul at St. Mary's church. Also, names are being taken for Thanksgiving Family Baskets which will be delivered just before Thanksgiving. The needs of Norton residents has really increased. Beth, as Human Services Director, has been very busy providing help to residents of all ages.

Programs continue to be very busy. Timmy Brown will provide a concert at the Center on November 15. Lunch and Learn on November 9 with speaker from Elder Legal Services, a service provided to seniors. Beth has written a grant to help fund the CAR transportation program. She has also written a grant for food to support the Lunch and Learn Program, which is very popular, and a grant for another farmer's market here at the Center. Next week we will be getting 2 interns from SE Tech school on Tuesday & Thursday to help here at the Center.
