Call to Order: 7:34 p.m. by Phil Zawasky, Chair.

Year End Transfer Requests

Selectmen asking to transfer \$421.00 from Finance Committee Reserve Account to the Selectmen's Salary Account to cover regular salaries. The need arose because there was a higher than anticipated raise for the Office Administrator and extra hours were put in by a Special Projects Coordinator.

The Fire Department is requesting \$1,078.00 to be transferred from the FINCOM Reserve Account to their Expense Account. \$747 of this amount is for reimbursement for training and class expenses relevant to the job. The \$331 balance is for the repairs done on some of the vehicles---they didn't receive the bill until now.

The Fire Department is also requesting \$2,589.00 to be transferred from the FINCOM Reserve account to their Salary Account. This is to cover regular and overtime wages for recent emergencies. \$2289.00 is the actual amount they need but looking to the future just in case.

Bill Gouveia moved that \$1,078 be transferred from the FINCOM Reserve Account to the Fire Department Expense Account. Seconded by Tom Deluca, Vice Chair. Vote: 7 in favor and 1 abstention (Tim Phelan).

Jack Nicolas made a motion to transfer \$421.00 from the FINCOM Reserve Account to the Selectmen's Salary Account. Seconded by Paul Helmreich. Vote: unanimous.

Paul Helmreich made a motion to transfer \$2,589 from the FINCOM Reserve Account to the Fire Department Salary Account. Seconded by Michael Fiore. Vote: 6 in favor, 1 opposed (Bill Gouveia), and 1 abstention (Tim Phelan).

Bill Gouveia moved to adjourn. Seconded by Tim Phelan. Vote: unanimous. Next scheduled meeting will be August 1, 1994.
