Minutes of January 12 were accepted. Vote: Unanimous

NEW BUSINESS

Architectural fees for the new Police Station are up to approximately \$158,000. Town Meeting voted to allocate \$125,000. Charles Thomae of the Police Station Building Committee estimates building costs to be \$2.1M. Nicolas made a motion to transfer \$14,940 from Finance Committee Reserve Account to the Police Station Building Committee Account. Seconded by Barrett. Vote: 7 in favor 1 opposed (Thomas)

Town Manager, Chris McCabe projected deficits totaling \$176,754 for FY98 budget.

McCabe does not anticipate any Drawdowns from Finance Committee for sewer fees.

A draft version of a 5-year Capital Improvement Plan is being printed this week.

Budget meetings are expected to begin by March 2nd Finance Committee meeting.

Annual Town Meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 8, 1998.
