# Southeastern Regional Vocational School

Superintendent Hager was present to discuss Southeastern's budget. Based on last October's enrollment figures, there are 4 less students from Norton attending the Vocational School.

### Voting

306 - Southeastern Regional Vocation School

Fiore made a motion seconded by Nicolas to move \$287,517. Vote: Unanimous

#### Water Department

Duane Knapp was present to discuss Personnel Budget for Water Dept.

- Overtime is approximately \$300 per year per man. FinCom suggested implementing staggered shifts to help cut down on the overtime.
- Water rates have not yet been established.
- Approximately 95% of the people are tied into Town water.
- Barrett expressed the need for the FinCom to know what the water rates are before Town Meeting. Need to know what will be coming out of the Surplus Account.
- FinCom cannot recommend a figure regarding spending without knowing what the Revenue figures are.

# Voting

Helmreich made a motion seconded by Nicolas to table Water Dept. 450 budget until projected revenue side is adjusted and how it relates to Surplus Account. Vote: Unanimous

#### WARRANT ARTICLES

Article 16 Discussion:

- Selectmen are expected to ask Finance Committee to reconsider article on Community School.
- Money is not included in the School Budget.
- Thomas feels we need to prioritize. There's only so much the Town can spend.
- The year 2001 has over \$2,000,000 in requests for Capital budget.
- When all the numbers are in on Warrant Articles, everything will have to reviewed.
