Present:

A motion was made and seconded to accept minutes of April 10, 2000 with correction to motion for Communications. Vote: 6 in favor; 1 abstention (Summerfield)

A motion was made and seconded to accept minutes of April 12, 2000. Vote: Unanimous

## ANNUAL TOWN MEETING ARTICLES

Article 21 - Animal Shelter

- Nicolas made a motion seconded by Helmreich to take off the table. Vote: Unanimous
- Nicolas made a motion seconded by Helmreich to raise and appropriate \$125,000 from Capital Improvements. Vote: Unanimous

## CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Nicolas made a motion seconded by Helmreich to move \$640,191 for Capital Improvements to include two changes: 1) change postage machine to \$5,948; 2) change Sewer pick-up truck to \$35,300. Vote: Unanimous
- Discussion: Town Manager, McCabe and Donna Summerfield, both members of the Capital Improvements Committee, gave an overview of the Capital Improvements Committee recommendations. Some of the highlights were as follows:
  - > Replace 3 Police cruisers
  - > Portable radios for Police Officers purchase 9 this year
  - > Pick up truck for the Fire Dept. (only item recommended by the Capital Improvements Committee for the Fire Dept.)
  - > Replace telephone lines at the Library. They presently have only four phone lines. The update will allow them to have a total of 30 lines.
  - > Replace the Highway Dept.'s 1989 truck with a new truck.
  - > Purchase sewer line cleaner (cost to be split between the Highway and Sewer Depts.)
  - > Highway Dept. Supervisor, Keith Silva informed the Finance Committee that the Highway Dept. holds onto trucks for 20 years. They are used to handle multi-tasks for about 10 years and then become single purpose trucks

## ANNUAL TOWN MEETING ARTICLES REVISITED

Article 16 - Community School

- Nicolas made a motion seconded by Fiore to reconsider. Vote: Unanimous
- Nicolas made a motion seconded by Brown to raise and appropriate \$42,784, Vote: 4 in favor; 1 opposed (Helmreich); 1 abstention (Barrett)
- Discussion: Helmreich feels the money could be put to better use. He feels this is a nice thing for the Town to offer, however, there are other needs he would like to see met.
