Discussion: Austin Senate was present to discuss the assessment process. He is a member of the potential assessment committee. Mr. Senate has been in fire service for over 30 years. He stated that the fire service is looking much more seriously at the issue of leadership. Requirements for the position of Fire Chief require skills different from those that were required 10 years ago or as early as pre 911. Town Manager would find the assessment helpful in evaluating candidates for the position. Civil Service Exam does not measure leadership. Mr. Purcell wants to provide most thorough and fair process. Board of Selectmen has decided the assessment process is not necessary since there will be a closed exam and the position will be filled with a candidate from in-house. Only top 3 scores in written test will be taken under consideration.
