## **MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at: 6:01 PM_

Minutes from the <u>January 15</u>, <u>2013</u> meeting were reviewed and approved with <u>no</u> adjustments. Motion made by Mr. Stefanelli, second by Mr. Ceckowski; all in favor, 3-0.

Meeting Motions / Actions and Summary of Discussions:

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Dated January 31, 2013, reviewed and approved in its entirety with no adjustments. Motion made by Mr. Stefanelli to accept, seconded by Mr. Salvo; all in favor, 3-0.

Executive Director's Report: January Timesheets for the ED were presented and accepted as is, motion made by Mr. Stefanelli, seconded by Mr. Ceckowski; all in favor, 3-0. Washer Dryer account deposit was presented; VNA Workshop, "Shopping for One" is slated for 2/27/13. Community Room Kitchen is nearing completion with only the sink countertop to be finished. The cost of this renovation to date is \$1498.96. A motion was madeto expend funds from the washer dryer account to pay for the community room kitchen remodeling expenses by Mr. Stefanelli, seconded by Mr. Ceckowski; all in favor 3-0. Street lights are finally all operational. Water heaters 7 units have been installed. Windows Phase II the bid opening is March 1st. We will hold a meeting to approve the low bidder tentatively on March 4, 2013. Budget FY 2012-2013 is about 3 weeks away from approval by DHCD. Flag for "You Are Not Forgotten" would add a nice touch to our flag pole. The Board will look into purchasing a flag from the vendor used by the Town. Formula Funding FY 2015 budget has been approved for \$191,082.00. The projects scheduled for these monies are siding and bathroom tile. Health & Safety Initiative has approved NHA for \$25,000.00 to make repairs to cement sidewalks.

<u>Combo Smokes – Jacobs Way</u> Bids were reviewed, the lowest bidder, Cornell Electric. A motion was made to accept as presented the lowest bidder, Mr. Cornell, by Mr. Stefanelli, seconded by Mr. Ceckowski; all in favor, 3-0.

<u>Regionalization</u> the proposal from the Governor and the proposal from MassNAHRO were discussed. <u>Sewer Commission Correspondence</u> The draft letter presented was approved.

## **Old Business**

NHA Benefits Policy was tabled for the next meeting.

Screen Policy was accepted as presented, motion made by Mr. Stefanelli, seconded by Mr. Ceckowski; all in favor 3-0.
