Items Discussed

- 1. Acceptance of Minutes of February 6, 2013 approved unanimously
- 2. SIP
- a. Looked at technology piece of Improvement Plan
- b. Most classrooms have Epson/Smartboard technology now; Mrs. Bolton would like one in each classroom
- c. May be some "points" available for purchase of these items
- d. Internet is faster now due to updated wiring
- e. Long-range technology goals for system discussed, may be revised
- f. Reading Dept. has been using technology to post various sites for parents
- 3. NAEYC
 - a. Accreditation process is done
 - b. Requires paperwork each year; review cycle is every five years
- 4. Blue Ribbon
 - a. Some work has been done

- p. Gia Sunderland wrote a Grant for parents
- 6. Safety
 - a. Staff member opens doors in the morning
 - b. Parents drop items for classrooms at the office; fewer people walking around building
 - c. Secretaries questioning if they don't recognize someone
 - d. Walkie-Talkies are coming
 - e. Crisis Plan is being revisited
