Old Business:

- 1. Policies and Procedures Review and Discussion-
 - Commission reviewed page 4 of policies and procedures document
- 2. Adult Recreation League Update and Discussion-
 - Kickball Survey- Survey was edited with critiques from last meeting and will be promoted starting anytime this week or next week.

- Adult Basketball Leagues- 12 women signed up, deadline for sign-up due by Friday. Program starts the following week on Tuesdays from 6:30pm-8pm at L.G. Nourse Elementary School gym. 36 men signed up. Program is on Wednesdays and Thursdays 6:30pm-8pm at L.G. Nourse Elementary School gym. Hoping to do 2 sessions starting next year from October-November and January-February.
- Womens Softball- Melissa will reach out to the program members for more information to bring back the program.
- 3. Fishing in Norton- Frank and Bryan are working on starting a fishing derby, which the North Attleboro Fish Hatchery will donate hundreds of fish. Thoughts on having a fishing league/membership which could have discounts on fishing equipment from local businesses. Hoping to have monthly events for fish outings.
- 4. ELP Vending Machine- Cost for a vending machine is about \$4,000-\$8,000 for a combined unit.
