**III. Open Space Map & Greenbelt Update**

Bill Buckley reviewed development plan for "204 East Street, Foxboro (August 10, 2011, plan 10-0124A)" Three options:

- Conservatory to purchase land for conservation purposes and access off East street ( preferred solution )
- Single Family sub division open space design
- Conventional open density

Will have to go in front of planning board, (Town of Foxboro) to pursue any further. Mr. Buckley brought this to the committee to get feedback from the CRAAC members.
