Minutes of the meeting held by the Canoe River Aquifer Advisory Committee on December 1, 2016 beginning at 1 PM at the Mansfield Town Offices, MBC Room, 6 Park Row, Mansfield, MA

Call to Order *Southworth called the meeting to order at 1:00pm.*

Review Minutes of October 6, 2016 Motion made by Fresh, seconded by Boette to accept the minutes. Approved. Carlino abstained.

Kurt Gaffney, Mansfield Water Operations Manager-Update on Mansfield's Water **Supply** Gaffney has been at this job for 18 years. Last year they pumped 623,000 million gallons of water. There are 9 wells, 5 are in Canoe River basin. He did not observe a drop in water levels in the wells last year during the drought. Mansfield has annual water use restrictions beginning in May. There are not many private wells. Received a letter from Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) stating that they would not be reducing the drought status, which is currently at Phase IV-basically only allowing vegetable garden watering. Water ban can hurt the water dept budget. Has iron and manganese issue with one of the wells. Is approximately 58 gallons/person.

The Resilient Taunton Watershed Network (RTWN) Bill Napolitano presented the RTWN program to develop a curriculum for healthy communities with a grant from Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). It is a collaboration of 18 different groups to promote more resilient communities. Offer assistance with open space plans, master plans, and zoning bylaws. They are looking to create a certificate program with the Citizen Planner Training Collaborative. Planning first pilot program with CRAAC and area towns for January 2017. Potential dates include Jan. 13 and 27 or Jan. 20 and Feb 3. Class should contain a few 90 minute sessions from 9am-1pm at Norton Public Library. Motion made by Boette, seconded by Sozio to support initiative. Approved.
