**6:30pm.** Meeting called to order. Commissioners Diane McElligott, Luke Grant and Steve Bishop present. Also present Rose Melito, Fran Yanuskiewicz, Steve Pedersen and Attorney Joseph Cove.

Attorney Cove: He was asked by the Board to complete the Certification of Title required for SRF funding for the Water Treatment Facility. He explained it became a very indepth undertaking as the Town used incorrect references on a 1970's Tax Taking. Further research showed (proved) a virtual duly authorized order of takings in 1965 clearly gives title. The Abstract and Title Certification report for the SRF application will be ready by next week for Weston & Sampson.

Commissioner McElligott asked with regard to the Wheaton land for the sewer pump station, we have the previous Town vote (Article#5 May 2014) and the Wheaton Contract is there any further vote or action needed or required? Attorney Cove answered no but did suggest that the Board ask Wheaton for a consensual taking, once recorded certification of title can be obtained. The Commission will confirm (with Town Manager) that Attorney Cove will complete order of taking.

Weston & Sampson Updates: CWMP – Hearing is complete, now under review by DEP in conjunction with MEPA process. DEP required more info for the Phase I waiver request as well as a two week review period extension.

MEPA – Copy of memo from Fran Yanuskiewicz to Page Czepiga discussed. Scope for the EIR should be in hand by mid April, the scope of work will determine the cost. A place holder for the May Town Warrant was requested.

Town Center Sewer Project- NOI meeting with Norton ConCom last night (3/9/15) Issued Order of Conditions for the Pump Station Site. Next meeting in two weeks – will prepare draft plan and address comments by that meeting. Hope to bid project in June 2015.

LG Nourse School – Update of costs. Gravity piece is the delta from going Route #123. Weston & Sampson will provide cost information and preliminary design report to School Superintendent Baeta. A site walk tentative for 3/27/15.

274 East Main Street – Further clarification needed regarding Odor Control; Design Reviews and Inspection Oversite. The Board authorized Fran to contact Attorney Quirk directly.

<u>Chairwoman's Business:</u> Notify Daggett-Crandall that the Department is not interested in purchasing land at this time.
