#### Joint Meeting with Select Board Meeting Minutes January 5, 2022

#### I. Call to Order by Chair

#### II. Appointments/Resignations/Retirements

1. Appointment of Steven L Bernstein as a Water/Sewer Commissioner.

Motion was made by Commissioner Steven Bishop to jointly approve Mr. Bernstein's appointment to the Water/Sewer Commission. Seconded by Water/Sewer Commissioner James Jardin. Vote: Commissioner James Jardin – Yes; Commissioner Steven Bishop – Yes, Select Board Member Megan Artz – Yes, Select Board Member Christine Deveau – Yes, Select Board Member Renee Deley – Yes, Select Board Member Michael Toole - Yes. Select Board member Michael Toole asked Water/Sewer Superintendent Frank Fournier to give an update about what's going on at the Water/Sewer Department. Superintendent Frank Fournier mentioned that in late November one sample location exceeded the Long Running Annual Average of 80 ppb (parts per billion). The samples taken at this location averaged to a total of 82 ppb. Because of the exceedance, Mass DEP requires a public notification to be sent to all residents; however, it is to be noted that this is not an emergency and nothing needs to be done on the homeowner's side.
