
RECORD OF MEETING MINUTES:

The meeting was held to provide an update on the project:

- o The 75% Design submission was made on 4/20/21. The project is still included on the State's 2022 TIP, latest schedule projects an advertising date by MassDOT in the summer of 2022.
- ATC members and the Town will discuss trail naming and consider keeping the same name as assigned to the Mansfield Section (WW II Veterans Trail) or providing a new name for the section in Norton. BETA reviewed some of the challenges with changing the name at the Town line
- Suggestion was made to provide a sign at the Town line, BETA will review with MassDOT prior to the next submission
- O The locations of proposed kiosks/interpretive panels were reviewed by BETA. The ATC requested additional interpretive panel at the Plain St intersection, the Dahl parcel and to provide 2 panels at each location a panel is proposed
- o BETA noted that the ATC/Town is responsible for providing the graphics that will be set into the kiosks and interpretive panels. BETA is able to assist with this task as we have on other projects however it is not currently included in BETA's contract with the Town.
- o BETA noted the parking at the Crane St intersection needed to be removed from the project, but additional parking spaces have been added at Fruit St. After further review, there is 1 additional space as compared to the previous design submission.
- o ATC asked if an alternate push button height could be placed at signal locations for equestrian users. BETA will follow up and provide a response.
- o ATC asked about the dimensions of the proposed interpretive panels. After follow up, BETA has noted they are approximately 36 inches by 24 inches
- The Town asked at what point can donations be requested from property owners and does the FHWA documentation need to be transmitted at that time. BETA will follow up with MassDOT and provide information to the Town.
- The Town may need to request additional funds for right of way impacts at the fall Town Meeting, however at this time, estimated damages are unknown as appraisals cannot begin until the 75% ROW plans are approved which is estimated to occur in August of 2021.
