- Adoption The Norton Board of Health hereby adopts 105 CMR 123.000, Tanning Facilities in its entirety with the following changes adopted by the Board. All tanning facilities within the Town of Norton shall obtain a (license) from the Board of Health.
- 16.1 <u>Licensing</u> The license shall be effective for one year starting on January 1<sup>st</sup>. An application for licensing of a tanning facility shall include a fee, Appendix A, in addition to the following:
  - The name, address, and phone number of both the facility and owner.
  - ii A list of each tanning device, including manufacturer, model, and serial number.
  - iii The name and address of the tanning device supplier, installer, or service agent.
  - iv A signed and dated certification that the applicant has received, read and understood the requirements of these regulations.
- 16.2 <u>Facility Requirements</u> The licensed facility shall at all times have the following available in the facility:
  - i A copy of 105 CMR 123.000 Tanning Facilities.
  - ii A copy of the consent form to be used by the facility in fulfilling the requirements of 105 CMR 123.012(D) (2) and (3).
  - iii A copy of the operating and safety procedures to be followed in the operation of the facility and tanning devices.
- 16.3 Report Of Injury The facility shall within five days complete a written report addressed to the Board of Health indicating any injury reported or customer complaint. This report shall include:
  - i The name of the affected individual.
  - ii The name and location of the tanning facility involved.
  - iii The nature of the injury.
  - iv The name and address of the affected individual's health care provider, if any.
  - v Any other information considered relevant to the situation.
- 16.4 Non-Transferability Of License A license shall not be transferable form one person to another or from one tanning facility to another.
- 16.5 Grounds For Suspension, Denial, Or Refusal To Renew A License The Board may suspend a license pending a hearing whenever the Board finds

that there is a situation causing jeopardy to customers at a tanning facility. A facility may not operate during the period of a suspension. The Board may deny, revoke or refuse to renew a license for any violation of 105 CMR 123.00 or any violation the Board's regulations.

- 16.6 <u>Sanitation</u> The operator shall provide to customers of the tanning facility access to toilet and hand washing facilities. Each tanning booth or bed shall meet the following requirements:
  - i Be cleaned and disinfected at least once every 24 hours.
  - ii Contain liquid soap, paper towels, and a receptacle for used paper towels.
  - iii Be cleaned and disinfected after use.
- 16.7 <u>Inspections</u> The Board of Health can inspect each tanning facility at any reasonable time.
- 16.8 <u>Violations</u> A fine of not more than \$100 and or a suspension of the license shall be assessed if any part of these regulations or any part of 105 CMR 123.000 are violated.
