PLUMBING/GAS DIVISION

RESIDENTIAL PLUMBING.....Application fee~\$30.00, plus \$15 per fixture
RESIDENTIAL GAS.....Application fee~\$30.00, plus \$15 per fixture
Replacement hot water heater (includes plumbing & gas).....\$45.00 per unit
COMMERCIAL PLUMBING.....1% of contract or \$100.00 minimum
COMMERCIAL GAS.....1% of contract or \$100.00 minimum

ALL PLUMBING WORK MUST BE DONE BY A MASSACHUSETTS LICENSED PLUMBER.

A PERMIT APPLICATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE PLUMBING / GAS INSPECTOR BEFORE WORK BEGINS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DOUBLING OF THE PERMIT FEE.

REQUESTS FOR PLUMBING/GAS INSPECTIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE INSPECTOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE INSPECTION.

****THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO PLUMBING/GAS AND ELECTRIC PERMITS****

When a permit for work performed is required and the work has been started without first obtaining a permit, the above fees shall be doubled, however, the payment of such fees shall not affect the penalties as set forth in CMR 780, Chapter 1, Section 118.4.

When an inspection is requested and the work is not ready for inspection, or it is not acceptable, or the building is secured or not accessible, a re-inspection fee of \$35.00 will be charged. This fee is to be paid at the Inspections Department prior to the respective inspector making a re-inspection.

When a permit is requested to be re-issued due to expiration or loss, there will be a charge of \$10.00.

All contracts to include material, equipment, and labor costs.
