Frank Gallagher PE and Muhammad Itani, applicant, were present to discuss the project with the commission. Gallagher began by going through his letter of 8/24/17 and the comments made by the commission's consultant, John Chessia PE. After a lengthy discussion about the roughness coefficient of the replacement culvert, Kadish stated that the commission will base their decision on the information provided and requested Gallagher continue with another topic.

Ollerhead read into the record an email dated 9/11/17 from the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP) regarding the missing information they requested in a previous letter. Gallagher will address them directly.

Goddard Consulting will revise page 3 of NOI for our records.

The remaining two issues include the replacement culvert and the proposed stormwater management system. Ollerhead read a section of the DEP stormwater handbook regarding the requirement of Standard 2 for projects to not increase the rate in the 2-, 10- and 100-year storms. Commission and Gallagher reviewed the stormwater summary sheet where the 100-year storm event rate is exceeding the existing conditions in the post construction scenario. To meet Standard 2 this project must provide stormwater storage so that the 100-year isn't increased. This includes not increasing the rate to the wetland, not just from the property boundaries.

Carrozza asked Gallagher to confirm the proposed pipe inlet elevation is higher than the existing inlet. Gallagher confirmed. Carrozza pointed out that, regardless of the increase in the rate from the infiltration basin's not meeting Standard 2, the increased pipe inlet elevation would back water up into the wetland, flooding more area than is currently.

A motion was made by Kadish, seconded by Carrozza to continue the project to the 9/25/17 meeting. Approved.

Carrozza recused herself from the meeting. Matt Shute PE, and Lenore White, Wetland Scientist, were present to describe the area to the commission. Shute gave an update of the progress on the revised plans and meeting with the Conservation Agent and Mansfield Conservation Agent.



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There were two remaining issues with the wetland delineation. White described the area near wetland flag B40. Carlino questioned whether the isolated area was actually connected to the bordering vegetated wetland via the intermittent stream bank. Lenore stated that she did not observe wetland vegetation or hydric soils in this area. Ollerhead asked if she augered the full 12-18" required for a soil probe. White stated she could only dig down about 6" because of the compacted soils of the altered rail line. Kadish stated he didn't think it was important to make the distinction between isolated and bordering vegetated wetlands. Carlino reminded the commission that this is the purpose of the wetland hearing; to determine jurisdictional areas. Kadish made a motion to accept the IVW flags as proposed and determine the area is not bordering, seconded by Ollerhead. Approved.

The second issue was the extent of flooding flagged by Carlino near station 162. Shute stated his plans show the topography doesn't contain enough water to be isolated land subject to flooding. Carlino distributed a picture of the area that does not illustrate an outlet and contains enough water to be a potential vernal pool.

Shute will submit the 9/9/17 detail sheet of the isolated wetland area.

A motion was made by Kadish to close the public hearing, seconded by Blood. Approved.

Mark Dibb PE, Brad Holmes Wetland Scientist, and Don and Jeff O'Neill, applicants attended the hearing. Dibb reviewed the email from the Conservation Agent dated 7/25/17 regarding questions on the delineation. Carlino noted most items were revised. One item remained.



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There was an isolated wetland that appeared on the plan we approved in 2006 but wasn't on the most recent plans. The property owner, Mr. Fernandes, had just requested a Certificate of Compliance at a recent meeting and stated no work had been done on the property. While investigating this, it was found that the Isolated Land Subject to Flooding had in fact been filled since 2006 as approved in a subsequent wetland permit but the floodplain compensation area was not constructed. Condyne wants to compensate for the filling now in the next NOI application. The 2006 isolated wetland location has been digitized onto the new ANRAD plan. Dibb will submit a copy to the commission.

Motion was made by Kadish, seconded by O'Reilly to close the public hearing. Approved.

Mark Dibb PE, Brad Holmes Wetland Scientist, and Don and Jeff O'Neill, applicants attended the hearing.

This permit requires approval from the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP) prior to closing the public hearing. Dibb gave a short history of permit approval for the property. All plans will be submitted by Dibb for the public record.

Dibb described the proposed alteration of the No Disturbance Zone as temporary for crane work. The area will be restored with native vegetation and the visual barrier will be installed at the No Disturbance Zone.

Planning Board and Conservation have sent the project for consulting engineer review. Horsley Witten has provided comments to the planning board. John Chessia performed the review over a weekend



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prior to his going on vacation. Some discussion about the isolated wetland was held via email since that time. Chessia was waiting for plans to be delivered prior to making a second set of comments.

Commission has decided that the compensation area for the filled Isolated Land Subject to Flooding (10,540 cubic feet) does not have to be constructed because of the sandy soils.

A motion was made by Kadish, seconded by O'Reilly to continue the hearing to 9/25/17. Approved.
