DISCUSSION

Woodland Green, Steve Bishop, Maintenance of the retention pond

They have been going over how to apply the products, Algae Defense and a herbicide, safely and with the least disturbance. It has to be applied based on instruction of the product. The pond has permanent standing water in it. It is privately maintained and owned. The pond may not be jurisdictional. The conservation agent needs to weigh in on the right process.

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Mark Manganiello, environmental consultant-Wetland boundaries have been approved. First plan has no direct impact on the wetland, it would be a buffer zone project. Jen suggested looking into alternative plans, eliminating the activity close to vernal pools. Adding a wetland crossing less than 5000 sq. ft. They want the commission's thoughts on the original plan versus the second option with the crossing. Bob Forbes the engineer. Lisa Carrozza says the first plan could have indirect impacts on 4-5 vernal pools with people converting to lawns. Seems the better option would be the second plan with the wetland crossing. The crossing would have less ecological disturbance to the area. Took into account to some degree topography, grading and stormwater management. Likely equalizer pipes will be placed on the wetland crossing. Buffer zone impact on the second plan and intrudes into lots that abut the vernal pools.
