


Commodities Supplemental Food Program CSFP (income eligible program)





This is John from the VA hospital. He sends his "thanks" to the Norton Senior Center for this beautiful lap blanket.





At the October 2020 Town Meeting... The town received approval of Norton voters to authorize the Select Board to purchase property for our new Senior and Community Support Center!

The proposed location is at 116-120 Mansfield Ave., which is Route 140 across from Jasmine Garden. This will be a stand-alone site for the Senior and Community Support Center building which will give us enough space for ample parking, an appropriate sized building, and outdoor space with access to the Norton Reservoir.

The next step is to secure funding for the construction of the building. There will be a ballot vote and another town meeting in the spring that needs to pass in


order to move forward into construction.

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
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
