Community Center Update

Permanent Building Committee Update - (Bob Briscoe)

Request for funds removed from the Spring Town meeting warrant. Selectmen have still not voted on site. The Christian Church was not one of sites presented to the Select Board but is a possible site. It would be more economical to tear down buildings rather than bring buildings up to code.

The COA would like to put information (pros and cons of each site) together prior to July 13th and COA should become more involved in the process. Separate site for center is preferred option. Plan to set up separate meeting to discuss pros and cons for each site.

DIRECTORS UPDATE

- *Tax Program* – Tax program has started back up. Three stations were created to allow for social distancing. Germ shields have been put up, masks will be worn and stations are disinfected in between each appointment
- *Grab and Go Meals* - These meals offered by the School Dept will end at end of June. There will be grab and go lunch option for Seniors starting in July 3 times a week. Bristol Elder Services has been provided cheese and chicken nuggets. There are a lot of services to help people meet food needs.
- *Strong Together Fund* – \$7,500 received to help people in crisis
- *Masks* – supply of masks is low (MaryAnn will contact some people that she knows are sewing them for donation).
- *Thanksgiving Baskets* – will not be available this year
- *Volunteer Appreciation* – Gift cards to Norton House of Pizza will be purchased in lieu of appreciation dinner. Sharyn will make gift cards.
