SENIOR CENTER UPDATE

Bob Briscoe shared DBVW's initial drawing of new center. Discussion ensued regarding the building and the following comments/concerns were made. Need access to offices and conference room from corridor

- Need waiting area for appointments
- More parking, need additional parking for bus trips, bus access
- Durable medical equipment storage area / private space for doctors and health care (blood pressures, flu shots etc)
- Giant truck needs to have access to food pantry loading area, configuration of driveway so that there is easy in and out
- One way entrance and one way exit to make it easier for senior drivers
- May be better to move food pantry to side where kitchen is
- Running driveway around the building would solve access issues of large truck and bus movement but would take away from the aesthetics and space for outdoor activities
- Fridge and freezer storage space looks small
- COVID 19 has created more need for food storage space
- · Need to know capacity for each room
- Is there enough storage area?

Upcoming meeting on Permanent Building Committee on December 14th. Gloria from the Cupboard of Kindness should be invited to get her input regarding the food pantry. Beth will forward information to Gloria.
