The Council on Aging meeting held on August 11, 2011 was called to order at 3:10 pm. Those in attendance were Joan DeCosta, Betty Fogerty, Yolanda Lague, Ruth Fahrnecker and Guy Wheeler. Tom Burke and Tim O'Connell were here as observers. They are going before the selectmen this evening for their appointment. Judith Desroses arrived late due to previous meeting.

Old Business: Yolanda Joan and ~~Betty~~ met with the Town Manager and Carol Robarge and Nancy from the Friends of Norton Seniors. This meeting went terrible. The 'Friends' were quite emphatic that they wanted nothing to do with the Senior Center. The Town Manager has been asked to write a letter to the Friends. There was much discussion about all the problems with the friends.

The Craft Fair will be held October 15th at the VFW hall. Ruth and Betty will sell \$5 raffle tickets for Texas Hold em. Joan will make the Tickets.

Joan mentioned again that she thought we should have a holiday get together for all seniors also stating that there would be too many people to hold it at the Center. She said there were 3,029 seniors in Norton which is an increase of about 50%.

Guy mentioned that most attendees at the Center do not sign in and so a discussion ensued as to how we could help this along. Joan thought

the volunteers could make sure they all sign in.  
The minutes were read (the wrong minutes at first)  
Reuth made a motion to accept both sets of minutes  
but Joan said with one exception and that  
being the amount received to the grant per  
each person. The sum of \$6.25.  
Joan has filled out the papers for this year  
and met with the Town Manager on Monday  
who had to sign this report. It will be sent  
to the State. The amount we should get from  
the State is \$18,700 something dollars. Joan  
said that last year we only got \$13,000.  
which was in accordance with the 2000 census  
figures. Because the 2010 figures were higher  
we get more.

Also the minutes said the painting of the building  
would be done by the Hwy Dept and it is going  
to be the Sheriff's dept.

Joan noted she had called Larry Enos to come  
pump the septic tank as Jim Dinsel said  
it hadn't been done for 5 years. Had places  
showing where it should be, had a backhoe  
and jackhammer and dug area up but there  
was no septic tank installed. Larry Enos came  
back and ended up just pumping liquids  
via white pump but this does not take  
out a lot of solids. Mayor Rick X could be  
put down there to help the situation. Had  
a leak because of flapper in men's room  
and new one has been installed.

At ice cream social people did not know  
there was additional parking in the back

so we need to get a sign put up saying Ad.  
Emmette at the State told Joan to call Rich  
Thorpe in Little Compton, RI regarding the  
program to teach the seniors and to order the  
program. The program should be paid by  
the grant. This will cost \$1295. Joan thought  
this was the program for the cards. Rich  
Thorpe came in Thurs. to install this and while  
he was there Joan found out this wasn't the  
card program. We have to have a 2 hour  
on the TV Training program but people  
still have to sign in. Then we have to go  
into program and fill in info. The program  
Joan thought we were getting costs \$4,000.  
Only 6 communities out of 351 cities &  
Towns have this. If you have money  
left from grant at end of year, you will  
be out down in the future year by what  
is left.

Read also in minutes about Medicare cards and  
Nancy dropped off 1000 100 of them for us  
to pass out.

The Hearing tests went well. The person said  
she could do these Tests for us every other  
month.

Regarding the Day Care luncheon, Betty has  
not heard any more but will follow up on this.  
The Elsie person charges \$100.

Foxwood Theatre - cabaret \$31.85 or \$32.95 plus  
\$20.00 should be \$53 or \$55.

Plants do gambling thing every other month.  
Craft Fair is not Oct 1st but Oct 15th.

The Treasurer's Report noted we have a balance of \$1,123.83. We made only \$7<sup>change</sup> on a wheel & tea trip. Report voted to accept.

Craft Fair discussed again. Tables are 4x8 ft. We need crafters. Yolanda has one table booked but she is advertising. Michaels and Joanne's will be contacted to see if they have a list of crafters we could contact. Cut off date is Sept 30th.

They wanted to say that the ice cream social was a great success. Judy was asked to send a thank you card to Epoch. Yolanda helped make it a success by her dancing.

Also Leora danced with the Town Manager. Betty brought up Wright's Chicken Farm, apple orchard for October and so this was discussed. Also brought up about going to Old Country Store in Mansfield. It was decided to do this in October and move the gambling trip to November for a price of \$35. <sup>Oct 19th</sup> decided on.

Joan said she had the Home Teach program booked for Sept and wanted to have Police Dept come and talk about scams. It ~~New Business~~ was thought to have a luncheon with this. Joan said the next meeting would be on Sept 8th. Judy said she would not be able to make that night because of doctor appts. Ruth said she would take the minutes.

Ruth mentioned we got a donation of \$20 from 84 yr old Emma who plays cards. Ruth sent her a thank you note.

Ruth suggested making June Chamberlain an Associate Member, not having a vote, but could still be part of us even though she had to resign because of commitments she would like to stay involved.

Motion made and voted.

Ruth also mentioned that Dennis is no longer with us.

The functions for Sept were again discussed and also the October ones.

Ruth is trying to make up a new coverage list. These being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5 p.m.
