Article 11 Helmreich made a motion seconded by Fiore to recommend.

Vote: 4 in favor; 2 opposed (Fiore and Gouveia); 1 abstention (Desrochers) **Motion Passes** 

Article 13 Gouveia made a motion to recommend and later withdrew motion. No voting took place.

Discussion:

Water Dept. will contribute \$350K

- Lombard will recommend taking \$500K from Capital Improvements
- Gouveia not in favor of taking from Capital Improvements due to upcoming expenses in the next few years.
- Helmreich would prefer to borrow rather than go to debt exclusion override
- Lombard not in favor of borrowing
- Selectmen will be discussing Article on December 5, 2002. They need to give the FinCom a plan for financing
- Gouveia wants it in writing that FinCom does not recommend if financing is done with an override
- Kimball in favor of taking the \$500K from Capital Improvements. Not in favor of override. He thinks that the State will look at the fact that we have reserve funds and penalize us.

### Straw vote to obtain the land:

Purchase with Capital Improvements/Stabilization

Vote: All opposed

Borrow Funds (10-year financing)

Vote: 4 in favor; 3 opposed (Gouveia, Fiore, Luti)

Debt exclusion override

All in favor

Finance Committee would view favorably of dropping option to purchase if we could get the 18 acres of land

Vote: 4 in favor; 3 opposed (Desrochers, Summerfield, Zawasky)

Helmreich made a motion seconded by Zawasky to take no action on the basis of lack of plan for financing

Vote: Unanimous
