Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

I. Approval of Minutes

Motion was made by Mr. DeLuca to approve the March 19, 2014 Finance Committee minutes as amended. Seconded by Mr. Thomas. Vote: All in favor, with Ms. Desrochers and Mr. Carignan abstaining. Motion carries.

II. New Business

Southeastern Regional School District #306 - Superintendent Luis Lopes addressed the FinCom regarding the FY15 budget. The total school budget is \$23,092,871, which is an increase of 1.73%. He noted that the student enrollment for Norton is 117, which is 8.6% of total enrollment.

Superintendent Lopes stated that the cost of transportation is outside of the budget. He said that the school is not allowed to charge the students for transportation and that the state is supposed to reimburse towns for transportation costs. However, the reality is that they only get reimbursed about 60%. He said that the anticipated reimbursement state aid for transportation is \$757,299.

Superintendent Lopes informed the FinCom that Norton's minimum contribution, set by the state, is \$1,161,724. With that, along with other costs such as transportation, Norton's total assessment for FY15 is \$1,240,944.

Southeastern Regional School Stability Account -

Superintendent Lopes explained that this would give them the capacity to generate revenue (from bus rentals, etc.) to use for Capital projects. He said that they already generate funds but do not presently have an account to put the funds into to build upon for use later on large projects, because they are not allowed to have a Capital Account.

Superintendent Lopes said that presently when funds are generated they need to be used within the fiscal year, but that the establishment of this account would allow for funds to accrue for use on larger, capital projects.

Superintendent Lopes stated that the intent is to use this account for capital projects only; however the law states that it would be allowed to be used for anything.

Mr. Tarantino said that he would rather see the SE School District go to the courts to request the ability to have a Capital Account than set up this Stability Account. Supt. Lopes said that he would look further into this.

Mr. Tarantino said that he feels that the fees that the SE Reg. School get for bus rentals, etc. should be a credit to the school's budget as opposed to going into a Stabilization account.

FY15 Proposed Departmental Budgets:

Mr. Yunits informed the FinCom that he has made \$242,424 in cuts to the overall budget since the last meeting.

Mr. Yunits explained that this article would change the by-law so that maps and zoning books would be purchased through the Clerk's office instead of the Building Department where it occurs presently.

Motion was made by Mr. Carignan to recommend the article pertaining to the zoning by-laws changing to allow the purchasing of maps and other zoning materials to be done through the Town Clerk's office. Seconded by Mr. DeLuca. Vote: All in favor. Motion carries.
