Our sections to finish for OSRP

Michele-Chapt 61- Michele sent an email about the ranking criteria for assessing open space parcels and requested that we discuss it at the meeting. Members agreed that the ranking criteria is still appropriate but changed 2 of the items. Instead of just rare species, we added BioMap and Living Waters as positive characteristics of a property to consider for preservation. We also updated the criteria of land being within the Canoe River ACEC and made it any land in any of the three ACECs.

Pat-accomplishments list from the last plan-Pat was not at the meeting and will discuss at the next meeting.

Michele has some of the Chapter 61 section and will email to Jenn so she can include them in the DRAFT OSRP to be sent to Division of Conservation Services next week. Jennifer went over a few other sections that need to updated including storm water management, the Three-Mile River ACEC nomination and the Section 504 Report. Members discussed the previous evaluation of town property and since no new work has been done, the evaluation shouldn't need to be updated. Jennifer will check with the town manager regarding the new designated ADA coordinator and policies.

DRAFT goals/objectives and action plan
