Crossing lights at schools was discussed. The light in front of Yelle will be installed as part of a town agreement with Cumberland Farms. A light at Middle School cannot be installed because we need sidewalks on both sides of the road for approval. The Solmonese School will be addressed with crosswalks on the reconstruction of N/S Worcester and W. Main.

A crosswalk in front of the new Community Building on Rte 123 will not be approved due to any sidewalks on both sides of the street.
