Description of Traffic Management: Traffic management will be used according to the Work Zone Safety Standard Details and Drawings. Contractor will begin I-495 NB starting by taking HSL/ML first(work to last approx. 2-3 days) and then moving over to LSL/BDL next(work to last approx. 2-3 days. Then the same order will occur with I-495 SB.

Estimated Duration of Work: 2-3 Weeks – Work to begin on Monday Night (11/28/22), but current plan is to work Sunday Night - Friday Night starting 12/4/22.
