QUESTION ONE:

Shall Norton approve the charter amendments proposed by town meeting that are summarized below?

Summary:

The Charter amendments approved at the June 7, 2022, Annual Town Meeting would create a centralized Department of Public works (DPW) to exercise all powers and duties provided by state law for such purposes. The Town would appoint a Director to supervise the DPW and provide policy direction overall, and for the Highway and Water Divisions. The currently elected Board of Water and Sewer Commissioners would be abolished and replaced by a Water and Sewer Commission appointed by the Select board; the incumbent elected members of the Board at the time the amendments take effect would serve as the first appointed members for a period of time equal to their unexpired terms.

A "yes" vote on this question would create a centralized Department of Public works under the supervision of the Town Manager and an appointed Water and Sewer Commission. A "no" vote on this question makes no change to the current organizational structure, with separate highway and water and sewer departments and an elected Board of Water and Sewer Commissioners.
