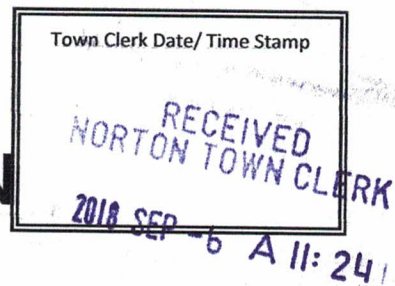




# MINUTES

### OLD BUSINESS.

2<sup>nd</sup> treatment at Winnecunnet will be done after ESS surveys.  
Barrowsville may be treated.

Brian Brady said it looks like 70% meltdown, treatment seems to be working on Winnecunnet

Dave Lennon found water chestnuts on the cove by Landmark on the Reservoir. They were pulled.

Dave Lennon passed around picture of Bryozoans.

### OPEN SESSION

.Discussed By-Laws with guest, especially regarding jet skis.

Town has new signs with messages about no alcohol, no trespassing after sunset.

Markers for dangerous places were put up in the Reservoir but were removed.

Dave Lennon emailed Chief Clark and was told that any one reporting vandalism, etc. do not call 911 but call Dispatch to report.

Fires are happening on Pheeney's Island still

Suggestion made that in order to camp on Island, people get a permit from Conservation. Also permit for fires so that they can be tracked and hopefully monitored.

Dave Lennon hopeful that new signage will work.

He thinks people are more aware now and are doing the right thing, and hopes that the Reservoir clean-up will have less trash.

People are still going out by Tsangs but don't know what will happen with new owners.

Brian said the boat ramp at Winnecunnet was not bad trash wise or by where boats are put in by Paula Driscoll's house.

#### NEW BUSINES.

New Project Reservoir clean-up should be week of September 9, maybe Sunday. Wheaton has volunteered in the past, and New England Ice Cream has sent help with the clean-up.

Suggested we try to get Winnecunnet and Barrowville cleaned up the same day.

Would need press release to try to get volunteers.

We need to reach out to Jay Barrows and Mr. Hewitt.

We need to get the Chateau involved with the clean-up and keep clean.

Brian talked to Manager previously, they are willing to do a Fund Raiser with 20% of sales during a certain time (maybe with coupon) for it.
