Thorndike Properties: Lloyd Geisinger and David Eastridge came before the Board to discuss the MOA-274 East Main Street and Sewer Capacity- RedMill Village

MOA-274 East Main Street: Outlined letter dated 2/13/15. The Board stated some points needed tweaking and more detail on technical language including:

1. Clarify it will be a six inch force main

2. More specific details/description on pump station

3. Language regarding 3rd party connections needs more detail and clarity about the condition of the pump station prior to the Town acquiring it.

The Board was told Attorney Freeman has not responded to Kopelman & Paige. It was suggested and agreed that a preliminary design of the pump station be submitted as soon as possible and a working meeting with Weston & Sampson be set up for next week.

Red Mill Sewer Capacity: Mr. Geisinger stated he has met with representatives of Island Brook and they are very much interested in his excess flow. They are willing to sign a contract/ agreement within the next week. Their proposed development will require approximately 19,000g/p/d. A spreadsheet was distributed with sewer flow calculations that result in a 19,739 g/p/d net excess at build out plus 10%. Island Brook is also prepared to pay capacity fees starting immediately. Mr. Geisinger said he would like to proceed with this deal and would draft an outline for the Board and Kopelman & Paige to review. Mr. Geisinger thanked the Board for their time.

All appropriately processed bills were signed and correspondence was read.
